4	Speaker Dr Rob Tayton	Dr Tayton gave a Power Point Presentation explaining the development plans for the West Berkshire Community Hospital, which was most interesting. Dr Tayton is the Chairman of Newbury and Thatcham Hospital Building Trust which has charitable status. The hospital was built through a legacy from Miss Rookes, a local landowner, and was built as a Private Finance Initiative (PFI). To date the hospital has developed through the Greenham Trust Wing which includes a Dialysis Unit and Cancer Care Unit. It is now hoped the hospital will become a Community Diagnostic Centre with proposed new facilities. A new MRI facility will replace the mobile unit, hopefully by the end of 2023 and a new CCT scanner and Digital X-Ray machines. Meanwhile many departments have been upgraded, Ultrasound, Endoscopy, an awning and ramps for the Rainbow Room, a new water supply for the Dialysis Unit, Security doors, the electricity supply upgraded and Car parking. The Chair thanked Dr Tayton for his excellent presentation and good wishes for the new developments.
